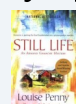
Body Butters & Sugar Scrubs

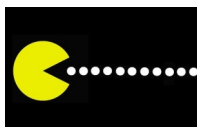


Rainbow Stress Balls

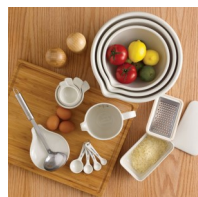

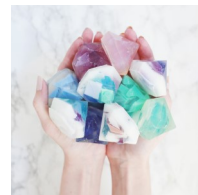

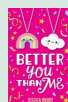
