The Goldfish Boy

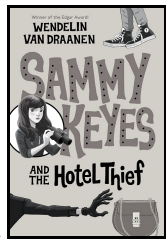
Because of his OCD, Matthew never leaves his room, but he watches everything that goes on. When a child disappears, he may be the only one who can help.

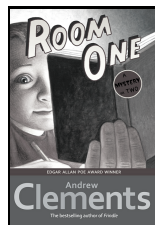

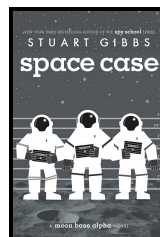

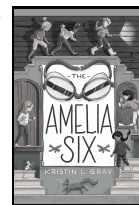
