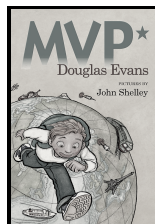


## HUMOR/FUNNY

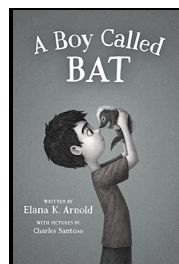

*Because of Winn-Dixie*

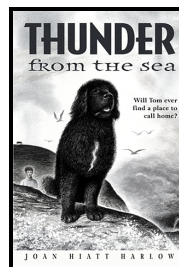
Opal describes her first summer in Naomi, Florida, and all the good things that happen because of her big ugly dog Winn-Dixie.

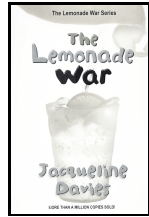
## FICTION

When two siblings learn they'll be in the same grade that fall, they get into a huge fight, then start competing lemonade stands and race to be the first one to make \$100.

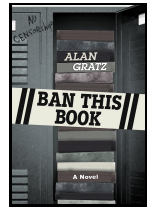

Astrid has always done things with her best friend Nicole– until now. Can she survive a summer as the youngest skater at roller derby camp and keep her best friend?

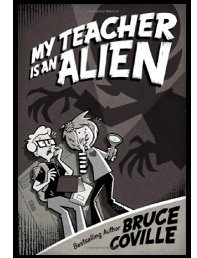
